### MASTERS OF CEREMONY:

Recently back from the Winter Olympic Games in Salt Lake City, Tracy herself is an Olympic hero. In 1988, she won the Bronze medal for Canada in figure skating (with the late Robert McCall) and is a seven time Canadian champion. Since hanging up her skates, Tracy continues to be involved in the skating world through her work as a CTV correspondent. Tracy is a member of the Order of Canada, the highest civilian honour given by the Canadian Government. Her dedication to Kids Help Phone and to helping improve the lives of young people are extraordinary, and we are very happy to have Tracy with us this morning.

Joining Tracy today, is her friend, colleague and fellow sportsman **Rod Black**. This is Rod's second year hosting the Mother's Day Breakfast and we are thrilled to have him with us. Rod anchors both CTV and TSN's figure skating and basketball coverage. As the voice of figure skating, Rod has been covering the sport on CTV for the past 10 years. He too brought us the latest news from Salt Lake. He has covered PGA Tour golf as well as CTV's Summer Olympic coverage from Barcelona in 1992 and the 1994 Winter Olympics from Lillehammer. Rod is without a doubt one of the most well-rounded and sought-after broadcasters in Canada.

### KEYNOTE SPEAKER:

**Jeanne Cooper** joined the cast of The Young and the Restless in 1973 as Katherine Chancellor Sterling. Ms Cooper founded a volunteer support network called the Katherine Chancellor Society and donates her time to several charities, hospitals and organizations, including Greenpeace, the National Wildlife Association and the Children's Hospital of Toronto.

She is the mother of three children, Caren, Collin and Corbin, and grandmother to eight.
